Lets all stay Healthy

Our number one priority is to keep the children in our care safe and healthy. Please do not bring your child to school ill. If your child becomes ill while at school, we will notify you and your child will need to be picked up within one hour. The Health Department's regulations prohibit the admittance of any child into a childcare center that exhibits any of the following symptoms:

-Fever 100F or higher -Diarrhea -Vomiting
-Runny nose other than clear -Rash -Lice
-Discharge from eyes or ears
-Any other communicable disease (chicken pox, pink eye, influenza, etc)

If your child shows any of these symptoms, please keep him/her home for a minimum of 24hrs. If your child has seen a doctor and been on antibiotics for a full 24hrs and/or symptom free, he/she will be allowed to return to the classroom. Thank you for your help with this matter- we know how important you child's health is to you and we want to do our best to keep all the children in our care healthy while at school.
