- Tuition is due each week by TUESDAY at 6:30pm. I can take cash, check, or card.
- Please make sure to bring in coats, hats and gloves that are labeled for your child, they will get to go outside some and we want them to be warm and bundled up.
- Our number one priority is to keep the children in our care safe and healthy. Please do not bring your child to school if your child becomes ill at school, we will notify you and your child will need to be picked up within 1 hour. The health departments regulations prohibit the admittance of any child into a childcare center that exhibits any of the following symptoms; Fever 100* or higher, diarrhea, vomiting, rash, lice, another communicable disease (chicken pox, pink eye, influenza, etc..) If your child shows any of these symptoms, please keep he or she home for a minimum of 24hours, if your child has seen a doctor and been on antibiotics for a full 24 hours or symptom free, he/she will be aloud to return to the classroom. Thank you for your help with this matter, we know how important your child's health is to you and we want to do our best to keep all the children in our care healthy while at school.
